## Approved trainee descriptions

Those undertaking a training programme must not describe themselves in a manner that either implies that they have specialist status or that links them directly with the EVDC, even if their credentials have been accepted by the college.

### Acceptable designations for trainees include:

a. For those in an approved EVDC Residency programme:

- \* Resident, Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Resident, Department of Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Resident, Dentistry Service

b. For other Trainees:

- \* Professional Interest in Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Practice limited to Veterinary Dentistry

Should a trainee wish to use an alternative designation they should contact the EVDC secretary and ask for guidance before doing so.

### Unacceptable designations for trainees include:

- \* Veterinary Dentist
- \* Veterinary Dental Specialist
- \* EVDC Resident
- \* EVDC Trainee
- \* EVDC Alternate Pathway Resident
- \* EVDC Alternate Pathway Candidate
- \* EVDC Board Eligible
- \* Board Eligible, Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Board Qualified, Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Specialising in Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Special Training in Veterinary Dentistry
- \* Special Education in Veterinary Dentistry

An individual who identifies their professional credentials or advertises themselves using any of these terms, or in any way implies EVDC membership or approval is likely to be in breach of Article IV, 2a of the EVDC Constitution and may be eliminated from the credentialling and/or the examination procedure.
